# **CAPTURE THE CACHE**

Capture the Cache is an exhibition of photography and art that celebrates the natural beauty, culture, and heritage of the Cache la Poudre River National Heritage Area. This juried art show of 30-40 pieces encourages photographers and artists to submit artwork **March 1, 2025 - May 2, 2025** for categories which include agriculture, community, and weather. The exhibit will be open to the public for viewing during the month of June.

Participating artists and show winners will be celebrated during an opening reception dedicated to art, culture, and community. The event will include a plein air art demonstration, hors d'oeuvres, cash bar and exhibit pieces will be available for purchase. During the event, Cache NHA emeritus inductees will be recognized in honor of their service to the Heritage Area.

# POUDRE RUNS THROUGH IT

**Poudre Runs Through It** (PRTI) is an invitation-only study action group of regional leaders and experts who reflect the diverse values of those who live and work in the communities along the Cache la Poudre River. Some members value the river as a working river for agriculture, municipality, and industrial needs, while others value recreation and ecological attributes. The group uses its experiences and knowledge to identify opportunities for cooperative action.



# LEARNING IN OUR WATERSHED

Learning in Our Watershed<sup>™</sup> (LIOW) is a field trip grant program designed to help youth understand the Cache la Poudre River and their water heritage while inspiring the next generation of river stewards. In 2024, 7212 students participated in LIOW field trips within the National Heritage Area. After their field trip, 89% of students said they understood how they can make an impact in the watershed.
