What you'll need to participate:

- Bring your 10x10 pop-up tent
- Staff your taster tent with 2 TIPS-trained servers
- Bring a table for your tent (as many as you need)
- Bring enough ice to keep your product at the correct temperature
- Provide a copy of your Certificate of Insurance naming Poudre Heritage Alliance and the Town of Windsor as other insured
- Signage and information about the beers you are serving for your tent
- Enough product to serve a 2-4oz taste of the products for 300 people you plan to serve (We will provide ticket sales updates leading up to the event.)
