--Parking: Street parking will be available around the Library Park area, but there is a parking garage a few blocks away at Remington and Mountain.

--Please bring your tickets via the Eventbrite phone app or print them out so we can easily verify your registration at the entrance to the event. **Tickets must be purchased prior to the event,** so if you have friends who haven't bought their tickets and are procrastinating, make sure to send them a polite reminder!

--If you plan on consuming alcoholic beverages, please bring proper identification so you can receive your all-access wristband at the entrance.

--If you bought an Adult 21+ All Access ticket, you will receive a reusable steel cup. There will also be compostable plastic cups for tastings throughout the day as well.

--March weather in Colorado can be unpredictable, so please plan accordingly. This location has indoor and outdoor space, so we will hold the event rain/snow or shine!

--Water stations will be provided at the beer tasting locations, so feel free to bring a refillable water bottle. (It's important to stay hydrated at 5,000 feet while learning about the region's water heritage!)

--The cabins and many of the features in the Heritage Courtyard are very valuable because of their historical importance, as well as the pieces of art in the galleries. Please treat the facility space and artwork with respect. **Food and drinks will not be allowed inside the historic cabins.**

--**NO DOGS or other pets will be allowed at this event.** That includes inside the Carnegie Center building and outside in the courtyard. Sorry!
