## What is the New “Study Outdoors, Learn Outdoors” (SOLO) Field Trip Program?

This school year, teachers will have the option to provide students with the opportunity for a self-guided, “Study Outdoors, Learn Outdoors” (SOLO) field trip. Two local educators have developed active, engaging curriculum routes based off the Poudre Heritage Alliance’s preexisting Wellness Program. 4th and 5th grade or 7th and 8th grade aged students can have an educational and fun experience safely by biking or walking routes on the Poudre Trail. A route map has the participant answering place-based learning questions related to the Poudre River that align with Colorado State Standards for education and their water heritage. Also perfect for families looking to get out, learn, and explore together!



Together, we can continue to build the next generation of river stewards even during COVID-19.

- An interactive learning experience created by local educators
